On behalf of the Committee appointed to consider your appeal against the decision of the Council of the Irish Amateur Fencing Federation regarding your expulsion I have been instructed to inform you of the Committee's decision.

After very careful consideration of your case the decision was to uphold the Council's action. However, we have recommended that the point regarding 'expulsion' does not mean that you may not re-apply for membership. We have further recommended that the period before which your application may not be considered will be two years and that after that period your case should be given a full consideration by Council if you re-apply.
